

Wichita Symphony Youth Orchestras Membership Requirements

- Students entering grades 4–12 are eligible to audition for membership on the following instruments:
 - Violin
 - Viola
 - Cello
 - Double bass
- Students entering grades 7–12 are eligible to audition for membership on the following instruments:
 - Violin
 - Viola
 - Cello
 - Double bass
 - Flute
 - Clarinet
 - Oboe
 - Bassoon
 - Saxophone (Wind Ensemble only)
 - French horn
 - Trumpet
 - Trombone
 - Euphonium (Wind Ensemble only)
 - Tuba
 - Percussion
 - Harp
- Membership is by audition only, and as a member, you must maintain active membership in your school's band or orchestra program on the instrument you are playing in WSYO.
- You must have the recommendation of your orchestra and/or band instructor to audition. Exceptions are made for students from schools that have no orchestra or band program, or homeschooled students. Those students must be recommended by their school official and their private teacher, and remain active in private lessons throughout the school year.
- You must include your school band or orchestra teacher's name and email in your registration form. They will be contacted ahead of auditions to make sure you have secured their recommendation, and that you are an active member of your school's music program.
- WSYO members must be present at all scheduled rehearsals and performances. No more than two absences will be allowed each semester.
