ABOUT THE CHORUS

Mission:

The mission of the Wichita Symphony Orchestra Chorus is to present choral masterworks of the highest caliber. The Symphony Chorus strives to maintain one of the finest mixed community choral ensembles in the area.

Brief History:

The Wichita Symphony Orchestra Chorus was formed in the 1970s. The first concert it performed was Handel's *Messiah*. The Chorus performs each season with the Wichita Symphony Orchestra. In the past, it has also performed in the Orchestra's Family Holiday Concerts and Pops Concerts. This season we are adding a stand-alone concert for the chorus.

WSO Chorus directors have included Randy Zuercher, Rod Walker, Dr. Cecil Riney, and Dr. Michael Hanawalt and interim director Matthew Udland. Dr. Ryan Beeken began his tenure with the 2021-2022 season and the chorus has grown under his leadership. The chorus now produces its own concert each season. The Chorus has performed, along with the WSO, under Music Directors Michael Palmer, Zuohuang Chen, Andrew Sewell and, currently, Daniel Hege. The Chorus has performed under guest conductors such as David Lockington and Jay Decker. In both 1994 and 2001, the Symphony Chorus traveled to New York and performed Handel's *Messiah* at Carnegie Hall under the direction of Robert Shaw. During the summer of 2019 the chorus traveled to Prague to perform *Carmina Burana*.

Rehearsal Information:

Rehearsals are held at Wichita State University in room C107 of the Duerksen Fine Arts Building. Rehearsal time is 7:00pm-9:00pm on Thursday up until the week of the concert. Occasionally a rehearsal may be held at University Congregational Church. Additional rehearsals may be called at the discretion of the director.

During concert week the chorus will rehearse multiple times at Century II Concert Hall, or Miller Concert Hall. Comprehensive information about concert week, including dates and times of rehearsals and warm-up rooms, will be provided to chorus members prior to the week of the performance.

Membership Eligibility:

The Wichita Symphony Orchestra Chorus is open to members of the community and surrounding areas who subscribe to the purpose and principles of the organization. At the discretion of the director, membership may be denied or revoked for failure to meet and maintain membership requirements, for consistent failure to comply with rehearsal policies, or lack of preparation. The chorus administration and/or symphony management has the right to deny membership to any person they do not feel will be a productive member to the chorus.

Requirements to Maintain Membership:

1. Attend rehearsals as required.
2. Display a positive attitude.
3. Be a contributing choral member to the goals of the chorus.
4. Miss no more than 25% of rehearsals per concert series.
5. If you are going to miss a rehearsal, notify the Chorus Assistant.
6. Complete the on-line membership form.
7. Maintain good condition of any checked-out music.
8. Return all music and/or folder at the conclusion of each concert series.
9. Pay for any lost or damaged borrowed music or folder.
10. Purchase rehearsal scores as needed.

Rehearsal Policies:

1. Be on time, ready to begin at 7:00pm, and stay for the entire rehearsal.
2. Check in on attendance sheets at each rehearsal.
3. No gum, candy or food.
4. Turn all electronic devices off or on silent.
5. Bring a pencil.
6. Bring a bottle of water..

Choral Scores

When the choral scores are provided by the Wichita Symphony:

A choral score will be checked out to each member at your first rehearsal. You will be responsible for maintaining that score. It is to be returned at score check-in after the last concert of each series. If for some reason you are not able to continue with the rehearsals for a concert, it is your responsibility to return that score to the chorus assistant within a week of your last rehearsal.

Please use pencil to mark any rehearsals notes in your assigned score. You may also use a highlighter, if you wish.

When each chorus member is to purchase a choral score:

As we look to the future, the Wichita Symphony organization will be transitioning out of purchasing, storing, and providing choral scores. Over time, chorus members will be asked to purchase their own scores.

Occasionally, you may be asked to provide a one-inch black binder in which to hold your music.

Concert Etiquette:

1. Absolutely no cell phones on stage.
2. No gum or candy.
3. No perfume or cologne.
4. No talking.
5. No waving to the audience.
6. No smoking during intermission. Century II is a smoke-free facility.
7. Follow instructions for stage etiquette.
8. Enjoy the experience – you’ve earned it!!!

Chorus Participation Requirements:

1. Be a member in good standing.
2. Attend all regular rehearsals with no more absences than 25% of rehearsals per concert series. Additional absences will be excused only at the discretion of the Choral Director or Chorus Manager.
3. Be punctual for all rehearsals.
4. Attend all rehearsals at Century II for the specific performance (unless *prior* approval is granted by the Conductor and Chorus Assistant).
5. Wear required concert attire.
6. Behave in a manner that is not detrimental or distracting to other performers at rehearsals and performances.
7. Make a musical and artistic contribution to the chorus.

Concert Attire:

Concert Black: Long black dress/skirt or black pants/slacks, long-sleeved black shirt/blouse (no sheer sleeves), if wearing a jacket, you may wear a short-sleeved shirt under the jacket; black hose/socks, black shoes, black tuxedo or suit with black oxford/wing collar shirt, black tie/cummerbund optional. General concept – a column of black, neck to floor.

Please do not wear/apply cologne, scented hairspray, perfumes, cream or oils. No jewelry except wedding rings please.

If you wish to purchase tickets for any concert you may call the Symphony Box Office at 316-267-7658 or you may order your tickets on-line. Tickets will either be emailed or held at Will Call. The Symphony Office is not currently open to walk-in traffic.
